- Embedding Learning Wall procedures and the use of exemplars and success criteria for English assessment tasks in 100% of classes;
- Attain the following goals:
 - o 100% of students from Yr 1 Yr 6 working to achieve an individual reading goal
 - 85% of students achieving an A –C for English
 - 85% of students achieving an A –C for Maths
 - o 90% attendance

Our initiatives include

- Engaging students identified through data analysis in our research based LLI Reading Program as a means of lifting individual reading performance;
- Enhancing our the school case management model, which identifies areas of need for individual students and links these to signature pedagogical strategies focused on maximising student achievement;
- Supporting teachers in the first five years of their teaching career through a multifaceted induction and mentoring support program;
- Building teacher capacity through targeted professional development, that uses data to guide decision making when differentiating the curriculum for all learners while deepening teacher understanding of pedogogical practices;
- Embeding the processes and protocols around the giving and receiving of feedback for all staff;
- Continue to use "Early Start" data gathering early in Prep with a view to inform teaching, learning and deployment of resources;
- Building teacher capability in the use of emerging and relevant digital technologies with a view to enhance and develop student learning;
- Continuing the implementation and enhancement of support, STEM and STEAM programs across the school;
- Continuing to provide quality opportunities for teachers to engage in appropriate moderation practices both within the school and across the geographical cluster.
- Embed data discussion procedures to analyse and discuss student data and set targets for learning.
